The deadline for lodging amendments is 12 noon on the fifth sitting day before the stage is scheduled to take place. For example, if stage 3 is due to take place on a Wednesday, the deadline will normally be 12 noon on the Wednesday before. There must be at least 10 sitting days between the end of stage 2 and the start of stage 3.
