The dreaded DBQ, or “document-based question,” is an essay question type on the AP History exams (AP US History, AP European History, and AP World History). For the DBQ essay, you will be asked to analyze some historical issue or trend with the aid of the provided sources, or “documents,” as evidence.

What is a DBQ? Document-based questions (DBQs) are for all students, from elementary school through high school. They are a type of authentic assessment and a way for students to interact with historical records.

*Document Based Question*

A document-based question (DBQ), also known as data-based question, is an essay or series of short-answer questions that is constructed by students using one’s own knowledge combined with support from several provided sources.

*How To Write Document Based Questions Lesson*

Document Based Questions (DBQ) assess the ability of each student to work with historical sources in multiple forms. The secondary DBQ will have a maximum of 8 documents; at least 2 of which will be visuals. The 7/8 assessment will have a DBQ with 4 documents (including 2 visuals).
