Dont Wreck Your Social Security

The lump sum benefit is based upon the date you first became disabled (your onset date) until the date of the allowance decision. If you file a new claim and you are awarded benefits, the lump sum benefit period starts on the date of your new claim and does not go back to your onset date. They have to by law pay you your social security before they consider SSI because the regular social security might be too high for you to get SSI. Don't post your private Email address.
