The guidelines require that “the sensor to detect absence of airflow for identification of an apnea is an oronasal thermal sensor.” 1 The alternative sensor for apnea detection, and the AASM recommended sensor for hypopnea detection, is nasal pressure.

In most healthcare room pressure applications, the minimum requirement is for directional airflow to be at ± 0.01 ” WC. The guidelines provide this number to ensure compliance can be met by all. But in best practices, real-world pressures typically run between ± 0.02 ” WC to ± 0.03 ” WC to compensate for sub-optimal HVAC system operation.

The AASM Guidelines call for a nasal pressure signal. The thermal device measures both nasal and oral airflow. A nasal cannula is less obtrusive than a nasal/oral cannula. Nasal/oral cannulas may be subject to a loss of signal due to pressure going through the oral prong.

Understanding Pressure Transducers and Pressure Flow ...

- The transducer must not be immersed in a chemical solution for more than three hours.
- Do not permit the transducer to become overheated (more than 60°C (140°F)) during cleaning, disinfection, and sterilization.
- The cleaning, disinfection, or sterilization conditions, such as the temperature and pressure, differ depending on the ...
