[22] The rights of detained immigrants are often further eroded as the result of problems within the administrative court system that hears immigration cases. Under international human rights law, every individual is entitled to a fair day in court. Within the United States immigration adjudication system, that right is often violated.

Asylum-seekers have the same rights as all other human beings – to seek safety and to receive a fair process. Yet, people seeking asylum in the U.S. are turned away when they ask for safety at the southern border or even deported without ever even having their claims heard in an immigration court.

Human rights violations against migrants can include a denial of civil and political rights such as arbitrary detention, torture, or a lack of due process, as well as economic, social and cultural rights such as the rights to health, housing or education. The denial of migrants' rights is often closely linked to discriminatory laws and to deep-seated attitudes of prejudice or xenophobia.

A 2019 ruling found that the government's Right to Rent scheme, which mandates private landlords to verify tenants' immigration status, contravenes international human rights law. Mr Justice Spencer found that the policy led to discrimination against minority ethnic tenants, both in the form of British citizens and foreign nationals.
