This includes waiving cost-sharing for emergency room, urgent care or provider office visits when the purpose of the visit is to be screened and tested for COVID-19.

Under managed care, states sign contracts with "managed care organizations," or MCOs, that provide medical services through their own networks of doctors and hospitals. The state pays the MCO a fixed annual fee for each Medicaid patient. And the MCO takes responsibility for overseeing each person's care.

The main difference between a managed health care plan and a traditional fee-for-service health insurance plan is that managed health care plans are dependent on a network of key players, including health care providers, doctors, and facilities that establish a contract with an insurance provider to offer plans to their members.

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
