Occupational injuries can result from exposure to occupational hazards (physical, chemical, biological, or psychosocial), such as temperature, noise, insect or animal bites, blood-borne pathogens, aerosols, hazardous chemicals ...

A total of 5,214 fatal occupational injuries were recorded in the United States in 2008, as reported by the Census of Fatal Occupational Injuries [].The most frequent event or exposure for these fatalities was transportation incidents (2,130), contact with objects and equipment (937), assaults and violent acts (816), and falls (700).
