This particular story can be found in the Ovid's first book of Metamorphoses , translated by Brookes More, starting with the line 89, after previously talking about the creation of the world and creation of first men that, according to Ovid, remains a mystery.

Ovid's Four Ages. The Roman poet Ovid (1st century BC - 1st century AD) tells a similar myth of Four Ages in Book 1.89-150 of the Metamorphoses. His account is similar to Hesiod's, with the exception that he omits the Heroic Age. Ovid emphasizes the justice and peace that defined the Golden Age.
