Responsive people express feelings more openly, enjoy working with people, and are concerned about the human aspect of issues. Both of these dimensions should be seen as a continuum. Your people style is based on other people's perceptions of you - not on how you see yourself. There is a self-assessment exercise consisting of 18 questions in the book to help you determine your style based on how over 50 % of people may perceive you (but it's best to get other's direct opinions).

5 Tips For Handling Different Work Styles Among Employees ...

Count up the responses to the four specific working styles: driver, expressive, amiable, and analytical. The highest score is your most dominant style. The wider the range of scores the more dominant the style. If you have two scores that are the same for your highest score, then you have two dominant styles.

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
