She chaired the Committee of Inquiry into Human Fertilisation and Embryology 1982-84 that resulted in the so-called Warnock report, published as Question of Life (1985). This, in turn, led to the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act of 1990 and to the setting-up of the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority a year later.

The Report of the Committee of Inquiry into Human Fertilisation and Embryology, commonly called the Warnock Report after the chair of the committee Mary Warnock, is the 1984 publication of a UK governmental inquiry into the social impacts of infertility treatment and embryological research. The birth of Louise Brown in 1978 in Oldham, UK, sparked debate about reproductive and embryological technologies.

In addition to Warnock, the new committee included five scientists, two veterinarians, one experimental psychologist, two laypeople and two representatives of animal welfare groups. 54 It also had a broader remit than previous committees, and was charged with recommending new legislation for animal experiments.
