Sir Gardner Wilkinson traveled to Egypt to study its ancient sites as a young man, remaining there for 12 years. His resulting book *Manners and Customs of Ancient Egypt* helped establish Egyptology in the UK and earned him a knighthood. 'Not a rich man' he and his wife eventually settled in a modest but ancient house on the Gower peninsula, Wales.
