*Practicum & Internship (M.Ed./Ed.S.) – Counselor Education*

The Practicum. Understanding the differences between a practicum and an internship will help students select appropriate degree programs that will meet their specific academic needs. The difference between an internship and a practicum lies is that the first is a paid, hands-on work experience, while the second is an unpaid, hands-off work experience.

A practicum and internship orientation is offered twice a year (see dates above). The student determines whether a prospective site meets the student's needs as well as the requirements for group counseling, practicum and internship as outlined by the CACREP standards and Washington Administrative Codes.

*What is the Difference Between an Internship and a Practicum?*

Students are expected to participate in both practicum and internship assignments. The practicum consists of one (1) semester within a public school setting under the on-site supervision of a professional school counselor for an average of 10–12 hours per week. In most cases, students complete their practica in school sites within Connecticut.

Internship. All students in the Counseling Programs are required to complete a three quarter internship. This involves 600 hours on-site (200 per quarter), 240 of which are direct contact hours (80 per quarter). Students also take part in weekly group supervision class on campus each quarter. As a student, you become eligible to enter internship after:

*Counseling Practicum and Internship - Liberty University*

Practicum training program applicants must be currently enrolled in a doctoral program in counseling or clinical psychology. In either case, applicants must have completed at least two years of supervised practicum experiences by the beginning of the fall semester when the practicum training program commences.

Field experiences are part of all of the counseling programs with practicum and internship (P/I) marking the synthesis and culmination of the academic preparation to become a professional counselor. A total of 700 hours will be spent in the practicum (100 hours) and (600 hours - minimum) internship, over a period of at least one year (i.e., three semesters).
