The Queen of Spades or Pique Dame, Op. 68 (Russian: Пиковая дама, Píkovaya dama, French: La Dame de Pique) is an opera in three acts (seven scenes) by Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky to a Russian libretto by the composer's brother Modest Tchaikovsky, based on the 1834 novella of the same name by Alexander Pushkin, but with a dramatically altered plot.

"Queen of Spades" lies at the upper end of the series' quality spectrum. It's a solid, musical interpretation that allows you to enjoy and understand the opera, without achieving excellence. The opera's protagonist is truly Lisa, not the obsessive Herman, and the story consists of her turning away from an arranged marriage and propriety, towards Herman, dark, alluring but ultimately crushing.
