Challenges faced by Newly Qualified Nurses. It is estimated that approximately 60% of the nursing workforce consists of newly qualified nurses; consequently there is much literature that examines the transitions that individuals experience as they progress from the student nurse to the newly qualified nurse (Whitehead, 2001; 2011).

Challenges faced by Newly Qualified Nurses ...

Theory-practice gaps, if strategies are not developed, can lead to segregation across newly qualified nurses and experienced staff, as when high expectations are placed upon newly qualified staff, they are unable to re-negotiate their new roles as they have no understanding of how their role can be limited by the particular socio-political and organisational constraints that can impede their ...
