Trade Secret. A trade secret is a design, formula, process or other piece of IP that is not known to the general public, which provides an economic advantage over competitors. Businesses can take steps to protect their trade secrets including requiring employees to sign nondisclosure agreements or contracts with non-compete clauses.

Trade secrets are a type of intellectual property that comprise formulas, practices, processes, designs, instruments, patterns, or compilations of information that have inherent economic value because they are not generally known or readily ascertainable by others, and which the owner takes reasonable measures to keep secret.
